[Studioplex Art Walk Is Wednesday](#)

Studioplex, the live/work community in Atlanta's historic Old Fourth Ward, will host its next 'Second Wednesdays' monthly Art Walk (www.secondwednesdays.com) on Wednesday, March 11, from 6-8:30 p.m. One of the highlights of this month's Art Walk is the opening of a new exhibition space in the Pavilion at Studioplex where the work of Elizabeth D'Angelo, Luke Haynes and Jason McGrady will be presented. The space is located next to Serpas True Food restaurant.

Recently recognized by the Museum of Contemporary Art of Georgia as a "Rising Mover and Shaker of the Georgia Art Scene," Elizabeth D'Angelo's paintings often speak of balance, health, and wellness and the human struggle for these.

Ashville, NC artist Luke Haynes will showcase some of his handmade quilts. Haynes paints murals in cloth and assembles mosaics from fabric. As Haynes notes, his quilts do not belong on the bed. They are "works of art for you to wrap yourself in during waking hours." His innovative pieces reconstruct half-remembered dreams, coaxing hazy morning memories into woven images.

As a fine artist and encaustic teacher, Jason McGrady's paintings capture a unique individual expression that includes new techniques and elements of the worldwide trend toward contemporary art.

In addition, a number of other galleries and lofts will be open during the 'Second Wednesdays' Art Walk at Studioplex, including:

- Griffin Davis Art will showcase abstract, mixed media works by Atlanta artists James Darden and Jorge Arcos along with San Francisco artist Zoe Martell (Suite G-5);
- Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) photography department will present "Making it Big: A Large Format Photography Exhibition" (Suite 143);
- The Dale family – Phil, Lisa and their 11-year-old daughter Angelique – will share their collection of paintings and handmade jewelry in their home studio in Loft 132; and

- Janke Studio, Atlanta's first complete glassblowing center, will have its amazing collection of glass objects on view (Studio G-9).

Art lovers and collectors are invited to come enjoy a complimentary glass of wine, discover exciting new artists in the heart of Atlanta and listen to DJ Tabone spinning his favorite tunes.
