**Local artist Dale Cheney will be featured at 'Fourth Fridays'
Art Walk at Studioplex in the Old Fourth Ward
October 22nd – 6 – 9 p.m.**

ATLANTA – October 18, 2010 – On Friday, October 22 from 6-9 p.m., Studioplex, the live/work community in Atlanta's historic Old Fourth Ward, will host its next 'Fourth Fridays' monthly Art Walk www.Studioplexlofts.com. The work of American artist Dale Cheney will be featured in the new sales center at Studioplex – space #505 in the Pavilion, between Janke glass studios and ABV Gallery.

A graduate of Georgia State University's Art School, Dale currently lives and works in Atlanta. His body of work primarily consists of portraits, abstract drawings, sketches and drafts executed in charcoal, watercolor or ink. An enduring interest in atelier drawing and painting informs his dynamic use of classical methods crossbred with modernity. Allied with a bohemian-punk culture and the hipster aesthetic associated with these movements, Dale draws upon traditions of classical interests and chooses to make them over again in a world all his own.
